RAPID RESPONSE TEAM (RRT) -

The state RRTs were placed in high-priority areas and provide reports to the state Headquarters where daily monitoring of containment area activities is carried out. Public health manpower is mobilized to support civil surgeons in districts and additional field staff is deployed for active surveillance in containment zones, wherever necessary. Strict regulation and maintenance of records about movements is ensured at the entry-exit points of containment zones. Implementation of daily door-to-door active surveillance is carried out by field staff with the use of thermal scanners. District health authorities coordinate with the Community Medicine Department of medical colleges for analysis of collected data.

GPS MONITORING -

Application-based screening of people in containment zones and those with SARI/ILI is conducted and GPS technology is utilized for monitoring movement of mobile teams through their live locations. Monitoring of home quarantined persons through video calling is also carried out.
