REHABILITATIVE MEASURES -

The state administration provided free ration including rice, gram, jaggery and salt during the lockdown period to BPL households. Above Poverty Line (APL) families were also provided a ration kit at a subsidized rate of Rs.10/Kg. The state government ensured doorstep delivery of cooked nutritious meals for beneficiaries of the ICDS scheme, and allocated Rs. 1 crore each to all District Collectors for setting up temporary camps for homeless families and non-residents. A helpline number was established at the State and District levels for the convenience of registered labourers stranded in other states amidst the lockdown and necessary help was provided to them.

COVID ISOLATION/CARE WARDS -

The State converted at least 100 bogies provided by the Railways into COVID isolation and care wards for accommodating up to 1800 patients. The biggest facility was prepared at the indoor stadium in Raipur, with the capacity of admitting at least 3000 patients, which provided everything from beds, plyboard partitions to slippers and clean toilets for patients.
