HEMOCARE -

A COVID-infected individual gets assessed by a dedicated team, who conduct home visits to assess if they are eligible for home quarantine. If the individual is allowed to stay at home, a yellow notice is pinned or displayed on the wall of the house mentioning the COVID positive status with the dates of initiation and completion of the home quarantine period. An ASHA worker visits the patient's house daily and enquires about their condition. In case the patient is experiencing any symptoms or distress, a team of doctors is informed for further action. Primary Health Centre/Community Health Centre doctors also call patients who are in home quarantine daily or once in two days to review their condition. If the condition of a patient further deteriorates, they are shifted to a Dedicated COVID Health Centre or Dedicated COVID Hospital. Pulse oximeters are provided to patients who are in home quarantine for regular monitoring of oxygen levels.
