- Manipur provided accommodation for the transgender community during the lockdown period and ensured trans women were not put into Quarantine Centres for men.
- The State Government launched a website for connecting with citizens who were stranded in other parts of the country during the lockdown period. The government also offered assistance in the form of dry ration, hygiene kits and financial aid of Rs. 2000 per person to students and other people from the state stranded in the national capital after the announcement of the nationwide lockdown.
