EXTENSION OF SERVICES -

The service period of over 400 contract-based Ayurveda physicians was extended by 3 months and a special allowance provision for staff engaged in COVID treatment was made within the first two weeks of the outbreak in the State.

CENTRAL COMMAND CENTRE -

A team of officials was formed as part of the Central Command Centre., which collected all relevant data for containing and managing the epidemic from District Collectors and CMOs. The team was also tasked with issuing instructions and guidelines related to the prevention of COVID. Guidance was provided to District Collectors on setting up Isolation Centres, managing individuals in home quarantine and designating hospitals and wards for COVID-19 patients in partnership with a team of doctors at AIIMS, Raipur.
