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How to use the set of SDGs poster

A Note for Educators

This set of poster is a part of an overall SDGs Education Pack developed by UNDP India. The Pack includes:

- SDGs: A book of action for educators & young learners
- 2. Set of three posters—2 designed posters (on SDG 5 and 14) and 1 'design your own poster'.
- 3. Set of 3 games on SDGs
- 4. A video on SDGs & youth action.

Guidelines on how to use this set of posters:

- The above pack will guide you and your students to learn more about the 17 SDGs and take action for SDGs. We encourage you and your students to choose and work on one SDG every month.
- Month-ends will be time for the class to present and showcase the work done on the SDGs.
- The 2 designed posters (on SDG 5 and on SDG 14) will give the class some ideas on how can they present their work on SDGs.
- Using the 'design your own poster' framework, the class can get creative in depicting & presenting their actions for SDGs, one-by-one, every month as they take action for the SDGs under your guidance.
- You will now have a set of 6-7 posters. You can guide the class to create an 'exhibition' on Action for SDGs, using these self-designed posters.
- This exhibition can be displayed in the classroom or the school corridor or even in the school assembly.
- In doing the posters, students can paint / draw / paster their own pictures of taking action for SDGs. They can create slogans, poems, games and riddles on SDGs. In case there are real products / material they have (like pieces of plastic from say a beach-cleaning activity), they may use these as well to design the poster;
- Some more ideas: Your school could think of creating a 'Wall of Action for SDGs' in the school reception area or a school lobby by putting-up the exhibition. This way, eventually, the school could declare itself as a school which encourages and facilitates 'Action for SDGs', in spirit, philosophy and practice!
