ABOUT THE SDGs

The SDGs were adopted by all United Nations Member States in 2015 as a universal call to action to end poverty, protect the planet and ensure that all people enjoy peace and prosperity by 2030. The SDGs are a collection of 17 global goals and 169 associated targets designed to be a blueprint to achieve a better and more sustainable future for all. The SDGs aim to 'leave no one behind' and to 'reach the furthest behind first'.





SDGCCs IN INDIA

UNDP, in partnership with the state governments of **Haryana**, **Punjab**, **Uttarakhand**, **Nagaland and Karnataka**, has established SDGCCs in these states. Within two years of their inception, these SDGCCs have proved hugely successful in fostering partnerships with people and governments in localizing the SDGs to the states, districts and, in some instances, even gram panchayats.
